

A Case Study:

CNCA provide a befriending service to elderly and isolated people across the borough of Croydon. One of our clients had expressed her concerns about falling as she had become increasingly unsteady on her feet. We talked with her about what she might need and contacted the Personal Safety Project at Age UK Croydon, who called our client to arrange a visit.

She is very happy and is now awaiting handrails, a perching stool and various other items to make her home safer and help her feel more confident.

We have been making birthday cards for our clients and personalising them. So many of the people we befriend have no relatives and little contact with anyone else so receiving these lets them know that they are in our thoughts and that people do care. They have been delighted with them.
