Croydon Council's rent subsidy scheme is now open for applications. The rent subsidy will be

awarded to successful applicants for a period of 3 years. The scheme will offer rent subsidy up to 100% of the contractual rent.

You can apply from 7th February 2020 and applications will close on **7th March 2020**. You will be notified of the outcome of your application in April 2020.

Please note that awarded rent subsidy will be for the financial year April 2021 to March 2023.



A.S.K.I. are launching, a chair-based and standing dance/movement programme specially designed to engage older people with dance/movement as part of our Active Ageing programme in 2020

The Concept

Following over 25 years teaching and engagement with dance Joseph Jeffers as devised a range of chair based and standing exercise classes designed for people 50-85. The classes use a wide range of music styles and movements which benefits older people including those with dementia and cognitive impairment.

Classes are for a maximum of 20 people and the session cost £50 per hour.

CNCA Updates



Here at CNCA we provide a service which is the only one of its kind in the borough. We offer a quality **befriending service** for elderly people with complex needs and those who are infirm, vulnerable, isolated and housebound, with

little or no face to face contact with people other than their formal carers.

Our clients are often people who regularly attended social clubs, but due to declining health, are no longer able to do so, but could benefit from one-to-one conversation and a point of contact in case their needs should change. We offer holistic support to clients who have extra needs, for example, they may need advocacy or help accessing other services in the Borough. Our service is unique in that we remain with a client for the duration of their life or until we are no longer needed.

If you are aware of clients whose needs have changed, or you feel the environment that your volunteer is visiting isn't safe, or they have any concerns, then PLEASE refer your client to us. Likewise, if your client has a diagnosis of dementia, then again, PLEASE refer them to us.
